Submission of Manuscripts

The Upstart Crow accepts essays, notes, and poems concerning Shakespeare's works. Please submit three hard copies of the manuscript. The author's name should **not** appear on the title page or on other pages of the manuscript; name, address, phone and fax numbers, and email address should be included on a separate sheet. Manuscripts should be typed, double-spaced (including inset quotations and endnotes), and must not exceed twenty-five pages (including notes).
