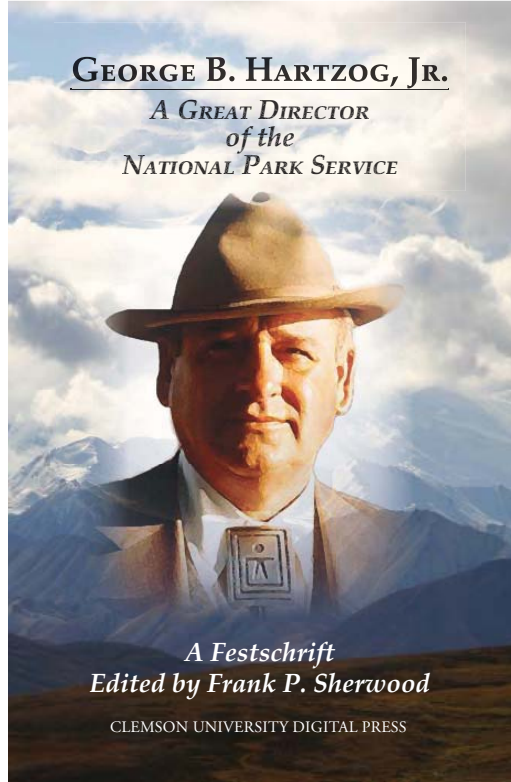

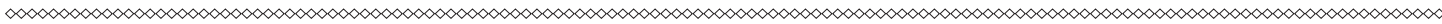
A GREAT DIRECTOR OF THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE: A FESTSCHRIFT
