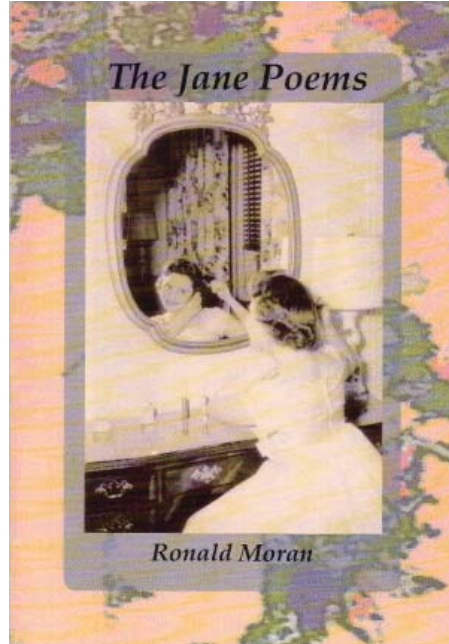


THE JANE POEMS ORDER FORM

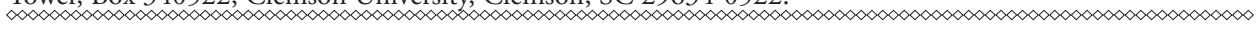
